TREE TRIMMING REMINDER.....

Trees should be trimmed to a height of 15' about the street and 8' above the sidewalks. The adjacent property owner is responsible to trim the trees. Trees and shrubs should never block a clear view of intersections, or traffic signs. Thank you for taking the time to examine your trees and maintain them. If you are hiring a contractor to cut limbs for you, remind them that they are to come into CITY HALL to get a permit for dumping on the tree & limb pile by the maintenance shed.
