#### **CENSUS 2020 IS COMING SOON**

#### Removal of snow, ice, and accumulations.

The abutting property owners shall remove snow, ice, and accumulations promptly from sidewalks. If a property owner does not remove snow, ice, or accumulations within 24 hours, the City may do so and assess the costs against the property owner for collection in the same manner as a property tax. The abutting property owner may be liable for damages caused by failure to remove snow, ice, and accumulations promptly from the sidewalk. (Code of Iowa, Sec 364.12[2b & e])

#### **SNOW EMERGENCY PARKING**

No person shall park, abandon, or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley, or Cityowned off-street parking area during any snow emergency unless the snow has been removed or plowed from said street, alley, or parking area and the snow has ceased to fall. When sufficient accumulation of snow exists, whether caused by direct accumulation or drifting the Mayor shall issue a snow emergency declaration. It shall be conclusively presumed that any snowfall of two or more inches, as officially measured at Sioux City, Iowa, creates a snow emergency. Vehicles left unattended on un-cleared portions of the street may be fined \$50 and require such vehicle be moved. City Code Chapter 69.10.
