Just a couple things...

-The fall city wide rummages are September 10 from 9am to 8pm and September 11 from 8am to 12pm. To be included on the map please register by September 7th. Forms can be found online on the LB FAMILY Group website, outside city hall, or on Facebook. The city will not be offering large containers for disposal. Donations can be brought to the Friendship Center Saturday, September 11 1pm to 3pm.

-Nice days for tree trimming are running out! Make sure the trees on your property are trimmed to 15' above the street and 8' above the sidewalks. Trees and scrubs should never block a clear view of intersections or traffic signs.

-Please do not park vehicles in front of fire hydrants, mailboxes, or neighbors driveways. Please park the same direction as the traffic flows. All vehicles that are parked on the streets must be moved within 7 days. Violators will be ticketed, then towed at the owners expense.

-Grass needs to be cut and weeds destroyed before they have exceeded 12" in height and in any event, by the 15th day of the month from May through October.

Don't forget! The last day to turn **ELECTION PAPERS** in is **SEPTEMBER 16 AT 5:00PM**. The Lawton City Council has two 4-year seats, one 2-year council seat, and Mayor up for re-election.
