Upcoming Ordinance Changes

The City Council are considering the following changes to our Code of Ordinances:

- ⇒ Sewer Rates to increase from \$15 to \$30 per month per household
- ⇒ Cars parked on streets during snow removal will be fined \$50 for the first offense
- ⇒ Adding a minimum residential housing standard ⇒ Restricting open burning



shall park, abandon, or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley, or City-owned off-street parking area during any snow emergency unless the snow has been removed or plowed from said street, alley, or parking area and the snow has ceased to fall. When, in the opinion of the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem, sufficient accumulation of snow exists, whether caused by direct accumulation or "drifting," so that snow removal must be accomplished, the Mayor shall issue a snow emergency declaration. It shall be conclusively presumed that any snowfall of *two inches or more*, as officially measured at Sioux City, Iowa, creates a snow emergency.

CHRISTMAS TREE DISPOSAL

City will pickup <u>live</u> Christmas trees at curb if they are set out by Jan 7th.

Trees must have all decorations and lights removed prior to placing at the curb for pick-up.

NO artificial trees accepted at curb or on pile!
