UTILITY BILLINGS

When paying your city utility bill, please remember the following tips:

Bills are mailed the first of the month and are due the 20th of each month. Payments received AFTER the 20th incur a \$25 late fee.

Return your stub with your remittance. This is the top 1/3 of your city utility bill and contains your account number, payment amount and name and address. It speeds up processing of payments. Also do not staple or tape your remittance to the stub.

If you have your bank send your remittance, be sure they have your correct account number with the city for their records. We receive checks from banks with "no account" or a wrong account number frequently. Please check with your bank when setting up your payment from them, and use the whole account number from your payment stub

For the ultimate in convenience, sign up for ACH service to have your bill paid automatically. You still receive your bill and have a chance to review it before payment is made. Payment is drafted from your bank account on the 20th, so your payment is always on time and you'll never have to worry about it being late.

And, don't forget, you can have your city utility bill e-mailed to you, saving paper and clutter, and it's good for the environment too.

ATV's, Golf Carts, Mopeds, OUV

- * All-terrain vehicles, off-road utility vehicles, golf carts, scooters, etc. may be operated on all streets within the corporate boundaries of the City of Lawton except U.S. Highway 20.
- * Operators must possess a valid driver's license.
- * They shall not be operated at speeds in excess of 25 mph.
- * They may not be operated within city parks or other city land, and they may not be operated on sidewalks, the trail, or the parking.
- * They must follow all the same laws as motor vehicles.
- * Check with your insurance carrier to determine what coverage you have should there be an incident. Some policies provide no or limited coverage on city streets.
